

Report on accident:

This report will state the facts about the car accident that occurred at the Lisbon Marquess of Pombal Square roundabout. The accident took place at 2 p.m. on Saturday October 18th.

The two cars involved in the collision were a black Porsche and a black BMW.

I was standing on the corner Of Brancamp Street, waiting for the green light when I saw the accident.

As I waited, I saw a black Porsche speeding by.

From where I stood I could see the man driving the Porsche was middle aged and had a beard.

He wanted to get through the orange light but when he got closer it turned to red.

At the roundabout a thin bald headed man in a black BMW was also driving very fast .

The driver of the Porsche tried to stop but it was too late. He smashed into the side of the BMW.

The man in the Porsche got out of his car very slowly. He had a cut on his head and he was stumbling around.

The man in the BMW was not hurt he ran out of his car and started shouting and insulting the other man.

That's when I called an ambulance . By then a crowd was gathering around the two men.

Then the ambulance and police arrived. The paramedics put the injured man on a stretcher and drove him to the hospital.

I gave the police my eye witness account of the accident.
